We begin this New Year of 2018 with a couple of new things for Bookwalter UMC. First of all, the Holston Conference has put into effect some significant structural changes. I have previously told you of the plans to change from 12 districts to 9 with a corresponding reduction in District Superintendents. That has now officially happened and the names of the districts have also changed. There is no longer a "Knoxville District" and our new name is the **Tennessee Valley District**. This may take some getting used to as I held off ever calling a certain shopping center anything but "East Towne Mall" for over 20 years.

Another change is our main summer activity for children. Instead of VBS this year, we have been approved as a host site for Holston Conference's **Camp in the Community**. This ministry is an effort to bring the camp experience to both rural and urban children who may never be afforded one. We have excellent facilities for this and we are very excited at the opportunity. We will focus on children from Inskip Elementary School and can have as many as 60 in attendance.

There is an expense for CITC and we are applying our VBS budget toward this and Edie is already working on some fund-raisers for the balance. We will also be responsible for housing the camp staff and providing meals for the children who attend. Our youth will have the option/opportunity to be trained and serve as volunteer junior counselors also. Please be in prayer for this new adventure. *Steve*
