Most of you are already faithful in many of these, but all of us have areas in which we can grow. You will note that many of our membership vows are reflected in this list. As a member of Christ's universal church, and as a member of this congregation, I will faithfully participate in its ministries by my prayers, my presence, my gifts, my service, and my witness.
