There is a cemetery in Hanover, Germany that has a grave covered with huge slabs of granite and marble cemented together and fastened with heavy steel straps.

The plot belongs to a woman who died in 1782. She did not believe in the resurrection of the dead, but despite her unbelief took precautions in case such an event might take place.

She stipulated in her will that her grave be made secure so that if there were a resurrection, God could not get to her. She even had her marker inscribed with the words: "This tomb bought for eternity may never be opened."

However, as time passed, a seed from a nearby tree, which had been covered over by the stone slabs, began to grow. Slowly it pushed up through the soil and out from beneath the slabs.

As the trunk enlarged, the great slabs gradually shifted so that the steel straps were torn from their sockets. This site is now known as the "Open Grave" or the "Burst Grave" and is a tourist attraction.

As surely as that tiny seed had the power to open the woman's grave, God can raise her at the resurrection. I take comfort knowing that God will be able to "get to me" when that time comes.

HANDS ON MISSION

Both the Smoky Mountain and Tennessee Valley Districts have been asked to put together 400 Food Buckets from each District for the 2024 Holston Annual Conference Hands-On Mission Project. These will be once again going to Zimbabwe.

Note: A \$5.00 donation for packing and shipping is to accompany each bucket. Each church is asked to bring ONE check for the total shipping amount.

* Do not put money in the bucket! Pack in NEW 5 Gallon bucket with lid.

Each bucket should contain the following:

- 1 bag Self-Rising Flour (4-5lb)
- 1 bag Sugar (4-5lb) (TN VALLEY ONLY)
- 1 bag of dried beans (2lb)
- 1 bottle cooking oil (48oz or less)

Canned Meat (Ham, Tuna, Spam) 2 lb total

- 1 bag of Rice (2 lb)
- 1 powdered/dried milk (56oz or less)

Delivery dates and times will be announced later.

Remember, food items have expiration dates! Please, make sure the expiration date is 2025 or later to cover transport time and having a useful shelf-life for the people in Zimbabwe.
